## Travel Flasks Instructions

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Before using your flasks, remove the security ring from the caps completely.

Gently rinse flasks with warm water before first use.



### Cleaning your flasks

Wash with dish soap and warm water.

Rinse well and invert the flask for quicker drying.



### When Freezing

Fill your flasks to about 70-75% capacity to prevent damage to flasks due to liquids expanding. Freeze flasks while they are laying flat.



### For Cruising and Flying

Fill your flasks to about 80-85% capacity and squeeze remaining air out before tightening the caps. Remember, air bubbles are detectable.

Conceal flasks in checked baggage by putting flasks in rolled up items of clothing or under and around objects like toiletry bags or shoes. Put flasks halfway down the luggage and avoid putting more than 2 flasks per piece of luggage.

Do not pack in carry-on. When reboarding, keep flasks on your person.

Do not put carbonated beverages in flasks.

Tip: If you are worried about leakage, you can always put your flasks inside ziplock bags for additional protection.
